<b>SUMMARY</b>	<p>On 10/18/2021 at 2021, I was dispatched to the University of Kentucky Medical Center Emergency Department in reference to a deceased male subject. I arrived on scene at 2054 and met with the hospital staff and the University of Kentucky Police in reference to the case. Reportedly, the subject was a student at the University of Kentucky. The subject was at a Fraternity House and was highly intoxicated, per friends. The subject had been drinking heavily during the day, reportedly hard liquor. The subject was later discovered unresponsive with vomitus on his body by friends. EMS was notified and transported the subject to the University of Kentucky Medical Center for care where he died upon arrival. I examined the subject, obtained medical records, blood and urine for analysis, and departed the scene at 2133 on stated date.</p> <p>No trauma nor foul play was detected in this case. No criminal charges will be filed in this case, per the University of Kentucky Police.</p>
