

AMBULANCE RUNS

Fern Creek Fire and EMS (Merged with Buechel Fire & EMS July 1, 2022; data merging both departments) Districts 1-50, 1-37, 1-71

2020: 8943 total calls (*for service*), 2244 to urban, **25%**; 1436 transports, **63%** (63.37%)

2021: 12859 total calls (*for service*), 3249 to urban, **25.27%**; 2022 transports, **60%** (60.12%)

2022: 13350 total calls (*for service*), 3845 to urban, **29%**, 2594 transports, **65%** (64.88%)

5 ambulances going throughout the day, plus paramedics in cars for Advanced Life Support.

Anchorage Middletown Fire & EMS Districts 1-12, 1-18, 1-20, 1-77, 1-77, 1-99

2020: 10,937 total calls (*for service*), 406 to urban, **4%** (3.7%); 158 transports, **39%** (38.92%)

2021: 14,075 total calls (*for service*), 1,355 to urban, **10%** (9.6%); 581 transports, **43%** (42.88%)

2022: 17,030 total calls (*for service*), 2,635 to urban, **15%** (15.47%); 1,139 transports, **43%** (43.23%)

8 ambulances throughout the day, all Advanced Life Support (ALS), which means each ambulance has a paramedic onboard. Each ambulance has a medic and an EMT. An EMS Battalion Chief is available each day in support if necessary.

St. Matthews Fire & Rescue **Districts 1-26, 1-16**

2020: 8506 total calls (*for service*), 2832 to urban, **33%** (33.29%); 1950 transports, **69%** (68.86%)

2021: 10,010 total calls (*for service*), 3639 to urban, **36%** (36.35%); 2506 transports, **69%** (68.87%)

2022: 12195 total calls (*for service*), 4926 to urban, **40%** (40.39%); 3252 transports, **66%** (66.02%)

4 Advanced Life Support (ALS) ambulances throughout the day. If down to 3 ambulances due to staffing (very rare), they add a "fly car" with a paramedic.

Jeffersontown Fire Protection District **Districts 1-33, 1-55, 1-88**

2020: 7767 total calls (*for service*), 1407 to urban, **18%** (18.11%); 970 transports, **69%** (68.94%)

2021: 9015 total calls (*for service*), 1794 to urban, **20%** (19.90%); 1124 transports, **63%** (62.65%)

2022: 7444 total calls (*for service*), 598 to urban, **8%** (8.03%); 333 transports, **55%** (55.69%)

3 ambulances going throughout the day, plus 1 paramedic/supervisor in another car, "fly car."

Okolona Fire Protection District **District 1-80**

2020: 5198 total calls (*for service*), 555 to urban, **11%** (10.68%); **57%** (57.25) transports

2021: 9485 total calls (*for service*), 1453 to urban, **15%** (15.32%); **60%** (60.25%) transports

2022: 12363 total calls (*for service*), 2380 to urban, **19%** (19.25%); **62%** (62.25%) transports

Run 4 ambulances during the day and 3 ambulances at night.

Paramedic/Supervisor car available.

Pleasure Ridge Park Fire District **Districts 2-40, 2-22**

2021: 13,083 total calls (for service), 3038 to urban, **23%** (23.22%); 1,883 transports (1,883/5846 dispatched...3638 arrived on scene), **32%** (32.21%) or **52%** (51.76%) after arrival.

2022: 14,632 total calls (for service), 4190 to urban, **28%** (28.64%); 2,769 transports (2,769/7,472...4913 arrived on scene), **37%** (37.06%) or **56%** (56.36%) after arrival.

3 full-time ambulances going throughout the day, plus 3 "fly cars" available with a paramedic/supervisor or an advanced EMT. They also have 1 part-time ambulance available with a part-time crew.

Highview Fire District **District 1-11**

2020: 3,347 total calls (for service), 140 to urban, **4%** (4.18%); 49 transports, **35%**

2021: 4,213 total calls (for service), 442 to urban, **10%** (10.49%); 240 transports, **54%** (54.30%)

2022: 3,811 total calls (for service), 521 to urban, **14%** (13.67%); 342 transports, **66%** (65.64%)

2 ambulances throughout the day, plus 1 "fly car" IF down to only 1 ambulance. Ambulances carry a 2-person crew with either 2 EMT's, 1 EMT and 1 Advanced EMT, or 1 EMT and 1 paramedic.
